MINUTES CITY OF EUREKA CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING MAY 11, 2021

There was a called meeting of the Eureka City Council on Tuesday, May 11, 2021.

Mayor Tammy Cantrell called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. Susan Wisdom did Roll
Call. Present were: Mayor Tammy Cantrell; Councilmembers Ginny Folmar, Bront
Luna, Carroll Sigman, Mike Wisdom; and Secretary Susan Wisdom. Absent was
Councilmember Debbie Childress.

First was the Canvass of the General Election held on May 1, 2021. Carroll Sigman moved that the Official Results Canvass Report from Navarro County Election administrator Dan Teed be approved. Ginny Folmar seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0. The report has Tammy Cantrell winning the mayor position with 71 total votes. Opponent Pamela Mieth received 52 votes. Mike Wisdom (unopposed) received 111 votes for Councilmember and Debra Childress (unopposed) received 75 votes for Councilmember. (Report is attached.)

There was a discussion of rumors that have been going around before the election. A copy of an unsigned letter that was mailed out to some voters in the community is attached.

Next was the discussion of variances and zoning regulations. Carroll Sigman moved that the variance Kim Tucker received on April 27, 2021 for the sale of fireworks be rescinded and that Mayor Tammy Cantrell contact Kim Tucker regarding the City's existing codes, parking issues, and drinking on the premises of the property. Ginny Folmar seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0. These issues will be investigated further as well as if variances for selling fireworks needs to be brought up yearly since they can only be sold at certain times of the year and there will most likely be at least a 6-month period where this business will not be active.

There were no public comments and no new items for the next meeting's agenda.

Carroll Sigman moved that the meeting adjourn. Mike Wisdom seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0. Mayor Tammy Cantrell adjourned the meeting at 6:10 p.m.
