WORK SESSION  
APRIL 5, 2022

There was a work session of the Eureka City Council on Tuesday, April 5, 2022. Mayor Tammy Cantrell called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Susan Wisdom did Roll Call. Present were: Mayor Tammy Cantrell; Councilmembers Evelyn Broxson, Angela Burnham, Debbie Childress, Bront Luna, Mike Wisdom; and Secretary Susan Wisdom. Also present was Philip Crowell.

Philip Crowell presented the Council with the information they requested to be sure he had everything needed for his Public Hearing for the three duplexes he is requesting. It was noted that if Mr. Crowell's request for the three duplexes is approved, that it will need to be noted on the Specific Use Permit that if the duplexes are ever sold that they will have to be sold as one (1) unit. Mr. Crowell's Public Hearing will be on May 3, 2022 and will be voted on in a meeting on May 10, 2022.

The Council began working on the Preliminary Draft/Editorial and Legal Review Codification provided by Franklin Legal Publishing.

It was decided that Susan Wisdom needs to ask Terry Jacobson what the City needs to do to get the travel trailer and storage buildings off the property on Hwy. 287 owned by Steven Isbell since his check was returned due to NSF, he has not done anything to rectify the situation, and letters sent to him are returned undeliverable.

Mayor Tammy Cantrell adjourned the meeting.
